

Good Distribution Practices (GDP) Approaching Compliance Berlin, January 16th and 17th 2018

OBJECTIVE OF THE EVENT

The Qualified Person (QP) is assuming the responsibility of GMP and GDP compliance of the entire processes that participate in the medicines supply chain: primary manufacturing (raw materials), transport, warehousing, distribution, secondary manufacturing (medicines), packaging and distribution to hospitals and pharmacies.

The objective of this event is to offer an opportunity to share the current requirements and practical interpretations, having open discussions on the different approaches than can be followed to meet the expectations of the authorities in a reasonable and efficient manner. The main conclusions of this meeting will constitute a valuable foundation for AFA to prepare the 2018 GDP Audit Plan for AFA customers in Central Europe.

AFA INTRODUCTION

Asociación Forum Auditorias is an International Association of Pharmaceutical companies based in Barcelona providing 3rd party audit services to the Pharmaceutical Industry.

It was founded in 2005 with the aim of establishing an organized platform to perform joint audits to suppliers. AFA activities are ruled by an Intercompany Protocol approved by all affiliated members. AFA carries out all its activity under a Quality Management System, accredited under ISO 17020 as a "GMP & GDP Inspection Body". Both constitute the pillar elements to ensure the quality, confidentiality and absence of conflict of interest for all AFA activities.

AFA is continuously improving processes and costs to provide the optimal service to assist pharmaceutical companies in their supply chain qualification activities. AFA operates on a "shared costs" basis, optimising the price of the audits by looking for the maximum number of sponsors to reduce the final price.

Originally, AFA started as group of local pharmaceutical companies to leverage and share the individual efforts they were spending to the control of the supply chain. The initiative resulted in a successful win-win platform, which is currently a reference worldwide. The result: AFA arrives to approximately 400 customers from 40 countries, having performed more than 1,500 audits in the last 12 years
